### **BAPTISM INFORMATION FORM 2024/2025**

Baptism is the first of the seven Sacraments of the Church. It is described in the Catechism of the Catholic Church as "the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit, and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as children of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the Church, and made sharers in her mission." What an extraordinary GIFT of God we receive in Baptism! It is also clear in these words that it can never be a private commitment but always a PUBLIC commitment to following Jesus Christ, as a member of the Church.

For this reason, it is **essential** that parents and godparents are concerned to ensure baptised children are brought up in the *practice of their faith*. This means participating in the life of the parish community, especially in attending Sunday Mass. This is <u>the</u> moment in the week where we gather to celebrate that Christ is Alive and Risen from the dead. Baptism is a sharing in the life of the Risen Lord.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES - PLEASE READ BEFORE COMPLETING THE BAPTISM FORM:**

<u>CHURCH ATTENDANCE</u>: We have an expectation that if a child is to be baptised that their parents are regularly attending Church. This is because you are committing to bringing your child up in the Catholic faith. If you are new to the parish, please introduce yourself to the Priest.

There is no charge for celebrating Baptism. However, a suggested **donation** of £50 can be made to the priest. Guests are also invited, if they wish, to contribute towards the upkeep of the church via a donation basket left at the back of the church, or the contactless device.
